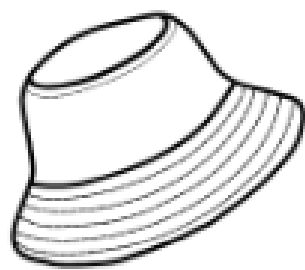
What to Bring to School
